Taste all wines

Taste and make notes by writing down in a note book dedicated for this purpose or if that's not possible make a mental note about the peculiarities of the wine.

A bad wine will also teach you a lot of things It's the best teacher. It tells you what all it lacks in its style and taste and why. This also helps you to appreciate and value a good wine.
