



A Wine Dispenser

The first time I happened to see a **Wine Dispenser** was during my visit to an upscale wine bar in one of high end hotels in the city. Placed neatly on a shelf against the wall, it appeared sleek and chic.

Touting it as another feather in the cap, the chief sommelier showcased it to the guests proudly. You place the glass at the designated spot in front of this machine, press a digital tab and **voilà! the wine pours automatically in the glass**, in a measured portion.

Technically, a Wine Dispenser is a device designed to serve and preserve wines. It stores wines at cool temperatures and prevents oxygen from entering the bottle when pouring.

Used in restaurants and bars, a wine dispenser prevents spoilage when selling wine by the glass. It also has the additional benefits of controlling the amount of the pour thereby limiting over-pour.
